Bekaa Valley

Blended from a variety of grapes including Cinsault and Cabernet Sauvignon. It is aged for up to two years in oak, producing a wonderfully rich and bold wine.

AUSTRALIA

580 **Cabernet/Merlot - 2006** £21.00

Karri Oak, Fengrove Vineyards

Distinctive ripe blackcurrant and plum fruit aromas and flavours. This is an easy drinking wine that displays richness and complexity.

585 **Shiraz - 2005** £39.00

Mitchell Winery, Clare Valley

The nose and palate show the spicy peppery characters of a high class shiraz. The wine has full flavours and has a soft, almost velvety palate.
